USDEI in Fall 2023

We're inching closer to the go-live date for students enrolling in a General Education Program (GEP) that includes a 3-credit requirement for US Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (USDEI).

As of Fall 2023, this GEP

- Removes Additional Breadth (3 credits)
- Adds USDEI (3 credits)
- Allows up to 3 credits of Visual and Performing Arts (VPA) to count towards the Humanities GEP Category Requirement
